1. Object of the Tender

This Call for Tender is aimed at a supplier branding products (hereafter "tenderers") capable of providing the following items for the Spanish Chamber of Commerce in South Africa:

Required Services to Support EYWA Subgrant beneficiaries' activity

- Pull Up Banner (850mm x 2000mm). Mechanism: Executive. Full colour, single sided print on layflat PVC
- Set of 2: Sharkfin flying banners. 2m height. Full colour sublimation print. Banners supplied with ground spike and carry bag
- Fabric table cloth. Size: 2500 x 1500mm. Full colour print on polyester display fabric
- 100 A4 Letterheads. Full colour, single sided print on 80 gsm bond paper
- 250 Business Cards (90 x 50mm). Full colour, double sided print on 350gsm.
- Foldable exhibition plastic table.
- 2 exhibition plastic chairs
- Maximum EYWA Subgrant Beneficiaries requesting these services: 26 women entrepreneurs

Service Period

- From 1 September 2025 to 15 December 2025.
- The commencement period is subject to change, and it must not affect the max budget allocated for it.
- Branding material to be delivered to beneficiaries within the overall project timeframe.

Provider Responsibilities

- Supply the EYWA Subgrant beneficiaries with the branding product as per clause 1.
- Maintain communication with the SCC the progress of supply of the products
- Inform the SCC immediately when a beneficiary stops working with you or doesn't send you the required artwork to do the branding products specified above.





2. The Spanish Chamber of Commerce Responsibilities

- Provide profiles of all EYWA Subgrant beneficiaries using these services.
- Communicate any additional information received from the European Union regarding the use of this service.

3. Contract Duration and Execution

- The contract will commence on 1 September 2025, or the day after formal signing, and run until the products are supplied to the beneficiaries. (not later than November $30_{\underline{x}}$ 2025)
- Any extension due to exceptional circumstances will be communicated in advance, subject to mutual agreement and no increase in budget.

4. Budget and Eligible Costs

- Maximum Total budget available: €9,750 (ZAR 195,000) exchange rate 1€ 20ZAR) for a maximum number of 26 beneficiaries.
- Maximum Budget per person per package: €375 (ZAR 7,500) exchange rate 1€ 20ZAR
- This includes all taxes.
- The Spanish Chamber of Commerce in SA will only pay for delivered products in case of delays or cancellations due to circumstances beyond the provider's control.

5. Tender Selection Criteria

- The contract shall be awarded to the tender offering the best economic value_—(the cheapest one).

5.1 Tender Admission Criteria

- Copy of South African CIPC registration certificate.

6. Billing and Expense Justification

Invoices may be submitted once the products are finalized and delivered, and the beneficiary is satisfied with it. Each invoice must include:

- Total cost per beneficiary
- Total cost for the products supplied.
- Reference to the EYWA Project, co-funded by the European Union

7. Submission Requirements

Tenderers must submit:

- Formal declaration of legal operation
- Legal contract/offer with all that's included in Clause 1
