1. Object of the Tender

This Call for Tender is aimed at internet providers (hereafter “tenderers”) capable of providing the following services for the Spanish Chamber of Commerce in South Africa:

Required Services

- 6 Months of 4/5G internet connection at a minimum of 50mbps for EYWA Subgrant Beneficiaries (maximum number: 26)

Service Period

- From 1 September 2025 to 28 February 2025.

Provider Responsibilities

- Supply the internet connection within a week of signing the contract

2. The Spanish Chamber of Commerce Responsibilities

- Provide profiles of all beneficiaries using this package.
- Communicate any additional information received from the European Union regarding the use of this service.

3. Contract Duration and Execution

- The contract will commence on 1st September 2025, or the day after formal signing and continue until 28th February 2026
- Any extension due to exceptional circumstances will be communicated in advance, subject to mutual agreement and no increase in budget.

4. Budget and Eligible Costs

- Maximum Total budget available: €6,201 (ZAR 124,020) - exchange rate 1€ 20ZAR) for a maximum number of 26 beneficiaries.
- Maximum Budget per person per month: €39.75 (ZAR 795) – exchange rate 1€ 20 ZAR-.
- The Spanish Chamber of Commerce in SA will only pay for completed services in case of delays or cancellations due to circumstances beyond the provider's control.

5. Tender Selection Criteria

- The contract shall be awarded to the tender offering the best economic value (-the cheapest one).

5.1 Tender Admission Criteria

- Copy of South African CIPC registration certificate.

6. Billing and Expense Justification

Invoices may be submitted once a month and only once the service is activated.

Each invoice must include:

- Total cost per beneficiary (-unit cost)
- Total cost for the services provided
- Reference to the services are provided for the implementation of the EYWA Project, co-funded by the European Union

7. Submission Requirements

Tenderers must submit:

1. Technical Offer:

- CIPC registration document
- Formal declaration of legal operation
- Legal contract /offer with all that's included in Clause 1

2. Quotation:

- Pricing breakdown (including unit cost and deposit).
